



4th Annual Car Control Clinic and Picnic

Saturday June 27, 2009 8 AM until 5 PM (Rain or Shine)

Driving is fun, challenging and potentially dangerous. That's why we're holding a car control clinic to provide members an opportunity to learn and practice car control skills that could be the difference between avoiding a crash and having one. The clinic is open to all drivers, but first preference will be given ARPCA members and licensed drivers in their households.

Drivers 16 years of age and older with a valid driver's license are eligible to participate. However, both parents must sign the waiver and a parent must be present, on site, for drivers under 18 years of age to participate.

- **Helmets are required. A limited numbers of loaner helmets will be available.**
- **Instructors will be assigned to all students.**
- **Students are advised to participate with the vehicle they drive most often, including SUVs. A Porsche is not required to participate in the clinic.**

The clinic will provide a foundation for performance driving for those who may wish to try a DE School later. The goal of the clinic is to raise your awareness of your car, surroundings and conditions when driving, so you can identify problems and to teach you and allow you to experience the appropriate responses to these problems. This is a better opportunity than on the street or track, where speeds are significantly greater and the consequences of a mistake could be costly. Besides, it's fun!

The clinic will consist of classroom instruction, in-car instruction, driving exercises and plenty of time for questions and answers. The afternoon sessions will be structured to permit students to apply the lessons learned in the morning to navigate an autocross course.

- **Bring your picnic basket. A concession stand on site will be open for lunch.**
- **Curious about all this? Come to observe and socialize with club members.**
- **Bring your Porsche and drive it or show it.**
