

# Shine, Drive and Dine

**Sunday, June 1<sup>st</sup> 2008**

**Out east, to the Jean Bonnet Tavern, 6048 Lincoln Highway, Bedford, PA 15522**

Join your Allegheny Region members for a drive east, to the Jean Bonnet Tavern. I did this drive two months ago, and you will enjoy it. There are twisties along the way, ample parking at the Tavern, and you can order what you like from their extensive menu. If you live east of Pittsburgh, I have planned several **meeting points** so you can join the group along the way, please see below.

**\*\*If there is a strong threat of rain on Sunday the 1st, the drive will be postponed until Sunday, June 8<sup>th</sup>. If there is a strong threat of rain both Sundays, there will be NO drive. To aide with communication in case of incliment weather, I need your contact information such as a phone number and e-mail address.**

## **1<sup>st</sup> Meeting Point**

For those in the **South Hills** and **North Hills**, we will meet downtown at the PNC Building which is just off the beginning of Grant Street when you exit the Parkway East. This is the newest PNC building overlooking the Parkway East (near jail) and the river. Parking is discouraged here, but due to the numerous churches located in town, our meeting place options are limited. At 8 am on a Sunday morning, I am hoping it will be quiet in town to gather the first group quickly, and then have easy access to the Parkway East from this location. Just look for a red 944 and other Porsches.

**Be there by 8:00 am, we pull out at 8:10 am.**

## **2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting Point**

Next meeting place, **Monroeville Turnpike** just before you enter the Toll Booths. Pull over to the right hand side of the road before the Toll Booths, look, and wait for other Porsches. **Be there by 8:45 am, we pull out at 8:55 am.** Once we all gather, we will progress through the Toll Booths heading East, to Exit 91, Donegal. But wait, another meeting place, #3 is next, see below.

## **3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting Point**

Next meeting place, after we get off the Turnpike at **Donegal**, we will drive a few hundred feet to the left and gas-up/park at the BP Station on the right and/or the Dairy Queen on the left.

**Be there by 9:35 am, we pull out at 9:45 am.**

## **4<sup>th</sup> Meeting Point**

If you're really far East, you can join us at the Rt. 30 and 711 intersection. There is a GetGo at the corner where you can wait for the group, and we should be **passing by around 10:05 am.** When you see Porsches, just join in. At this location, we will not be stopping here for any length of time, just passing by. From here it is all Rt. 30, a straight shot to the Jean Bonnet Tavern. As we enter Bedford, we will be driving down a hill and the Tavern will be on the right. We should arrive around 11:00 am or a bit before.
